


Consensus Building in Asia

The key question for this Tokyo workshop will be: How can we deal more effectively with conveners and our clients?

- Who are conveners and
- Who are our clients?
- What is "deal" and effectively

• Experts from Asia and the rest of the world will spend three days to present and discuss their knowledge and experience with consensus building processes. 11 steps processes of deliberation modified from the previous successful Dispute Resolution Process in the fights between the villagers and the Petrochemical Factory in Rayong Province.

- 1) Getting the *information* of who are the stakeholders and what are their concerns.
- 2) Meet the **leaders** of each parties, both "pro", "concern" and other "citizens" to agree on the primary **goal of** *working together*.
- 3) Build "*Trust*" between the facilitators and the communities through small group meeting through out the community.
- 4) Select the "working team" to work and plan together for the engagement by the stakeholders.
- 5) Give workshop to all the parties to create "understanding" and practices in "Communication Skills" and the process of "deliberation" for the involved key leaders (Use the knowledge-based power)

11 steps processes of deliberation modified from the previous successful Dispute Resolution Process in the fights between the villagers and the Petrochemical Factory in Rayong Province.

- 6) Set up the "Goals" or "Vision" together with the right "Naming" of the future plan. (not the position-based goals).
- 7) Create the "Issues Book" together with the expert consultants in subject matter to include 3-4 Scenario with the neutral consideration of the possible consequences both the weak and strong points.
- 8) Review and edit the issues book by the pro and con group to get the *common ground* on the "final draft issues book" to be used.
- 9) Randomize the potential stakeholders to come to the planned forum and *inform them in advance* of the deliberative process with the "final draft issues book" to read and review in advance.
- 10) Organize the "Citizens Dialogue" or "Public Deliberation" forum to use the consensus building in decision process in the outcome.
- 11) Summarise the whole process and the outcome to report to the community and the decision-makers.
